FORMAT

- 12 weeks of play on Sundays starting in May (see league portal for schedule)
- 9-hole One Couple Scramble.
- We will alternate front and back nine during the season.
- The league will be comprised of two Divisions.
 - 1pm and 4pm
- Each division will have its own season ending Champion based on total points accumulated for the 8 best rounds. See the points table below. Teams must participate in at least 8 weeks of league to win the season ending Championship. No money will be awarded but division champs names will be added to the LSCC Couples League plaque.
- Tees
 - Men: Blue/ White
 - Women: Red
 - Women 60+: Green
 - Men 60 +: Gold
 - Men 80+: Green
 - Hole 12 is played from the corner gold tee.
- You may not have a gross score that exceeds double bogey on any given hole.
- Play the ball up everywhere.
 - You may move the ball one club length no closer to the hole keeping ball in same cut of grass.
- Close to pin prize on #8 or #14 and long putt prize on #9 or #15, depending on which side we play...front or back.
- Rain outs will be the decision of course management.
 - Rain outs will not be rescheduled.

FEES

- \$100 per couple
 - League fees due by the second week of league. Someone will be available in the clubhouse for the first two weeks of play to collect.

SCHEDULE

- Schedule and pairings will be made in advance posted on the website League page and available the first week of league.
- We will work around play going on during the rounds, however limited greens fee play will be considered.
- Scorecards can be picked up in the clubhouse prior to your round.

- Turn your scorecard into the clubhouse when done.

HANDICAPS AND PRIZE MONEY

- Teams will start the first week with their ending handicap from prior season. After the first two rounds are scored, the new handicap is in effect and last year's score will be discarded.
- New teams use 85% rule listed below for the first two weeks.
 - 85% rule rounded down in place for first two rounds (applies to new teams or teams that did not play the previous year)
 - Example:
 - a. Couple shoots gross 43 (7 over)
 - b. $7 \times 85\% = 5.95$.
 - c. Rounded down is a 5 handicap for that round, net 41
- After two rounds completed a 90% running average cumulative to par will be in place for the duration of league play
 - Example:
 - After 2 rounds (43 and 48) couples average is 45.5
 - Relative to par (45.5-36) = 9.5 over
 - 90% of 9.5 = 8.55
 - Rounded down Handicap is 8
- The handicap will be figured out weekly based on previous week's scores and available to view on website.
- Scorecard playoff to break ties.
- Weekly closest to Pin and Longest Putt awarded in each division.
 - Closest to the Pin \$10
 - Longest Putt \$10
- Season Long Points allocation using best 8 rounds in each division.
